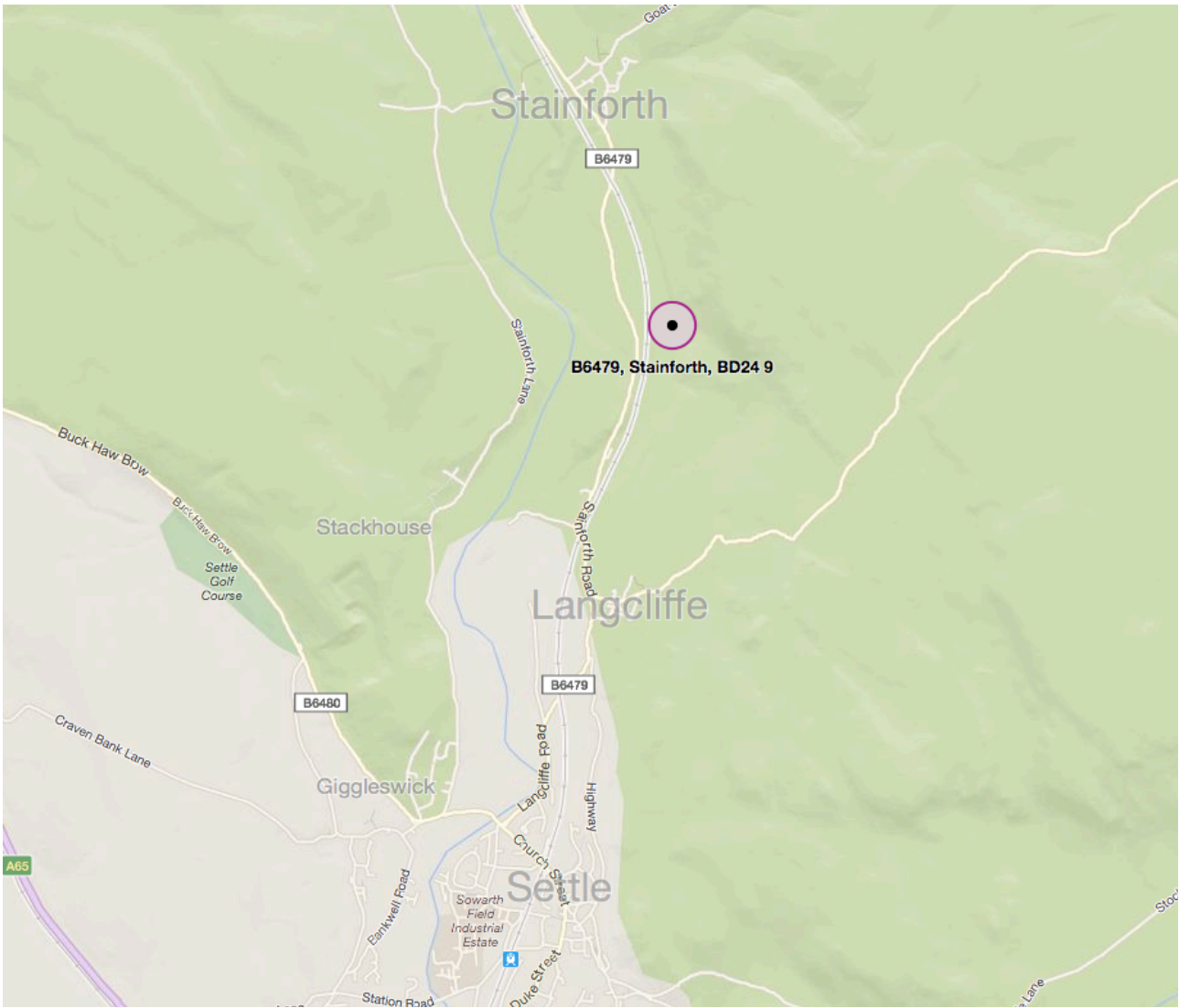

<p>DIRECTIONS</p>	<p>FROM SETTLE: Take the B6479 'Lancliffe Road' out of the town. After approximately 1 mile you will see a mill building on your left opposite a side road. Turn right on the side road, going under the railway bridge. At the top of the hill keep left. You will eventually see a row of terraced houses, just before reaching them turn right. The car park is at the top of the slope.</p> <p>FROM HORTON-IN-RIBBLESDALE: Follow the B6479 towards Settle. After passing Stainforth Village keep an eye out for a large industrial building on your right. Take your next left onto a small road, going under the railway bridge. At the top of the hill keep left. You will eventually see a row of terraced houses, just before reaching them turn right. The car park is at the top of the slope.</p> <p>The turning off the B6479 can be very easy to miss. Keep an eye out for the Yorkshire Photo Walks 'A' Board which will prompt you to turn.</p>
