<p>TO MEETING POINT</p>	<p>FROM THE A65 (SKIPTON): Take the B6265 from Skipton towards Cracoe, Threshfield and Grassington. On reaching Threshfield take the right hand turn before the Spar fuel station, signposted Grassington. Follow this road down the hill and over the river. After climbing the road bends to the right at the bottom of the main street, keep going for approximately quarter of a mile. The car park entrance is on the right.</p> <p>FROM PATELEY BRIDGE: Follow the B6265 over the moors towards Grassington. On reaching the village the car park entrance is on the left hand side.</p>
