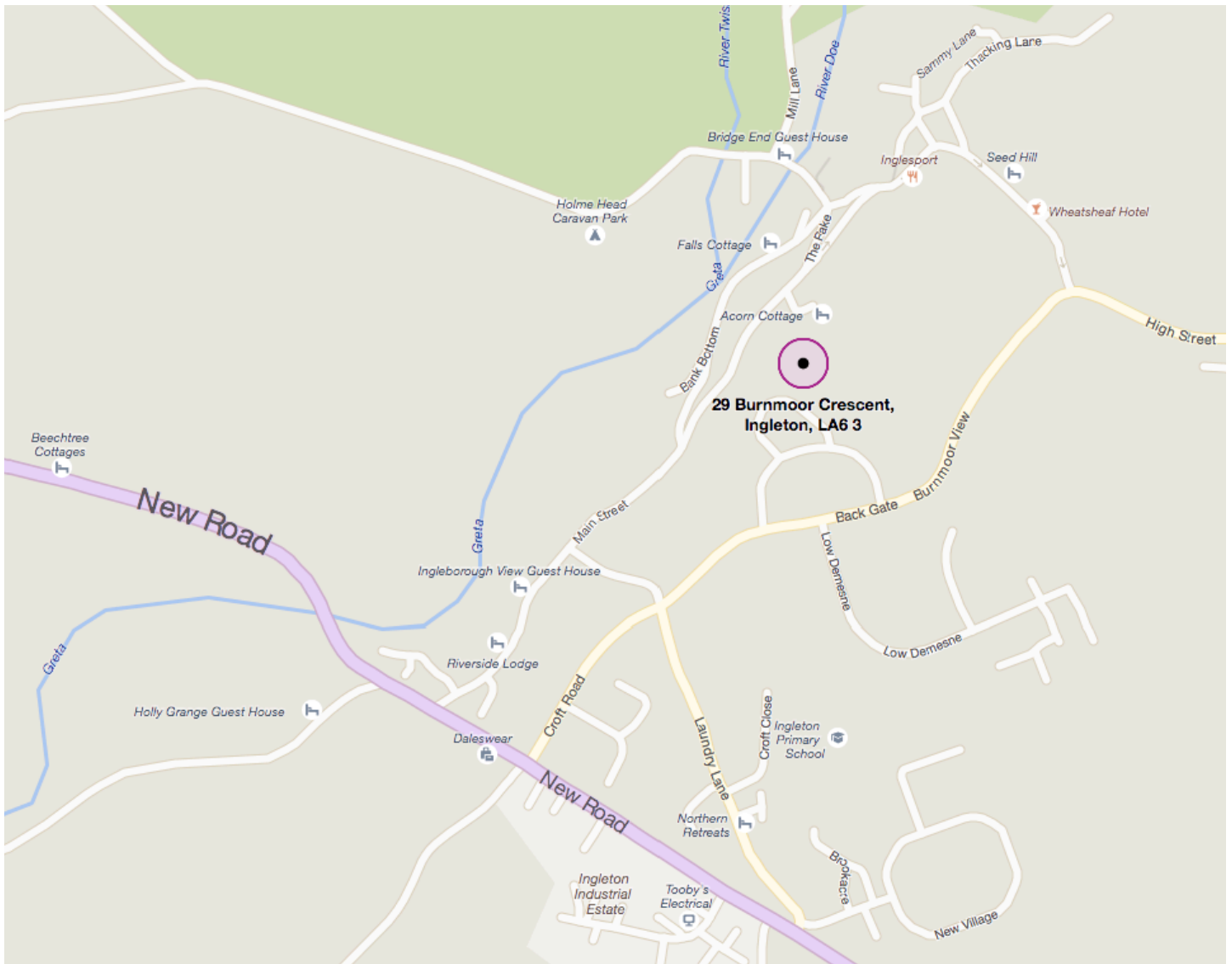

LOCATION DIRECTIONS

<p>TO MEETING POINT</p>	<p>FROM A65 EASTBOUND: After crossing the bridge over the river take the first left onto 'Main Street,' signposted village centre. Follow the road for approximately 1/2 a mile. The entrance to the car park is on the right just before the old railway bridge.</p> <p>FROM A65 WESTBOUND: After entering Ingleton take the right turn opposite the fuel station and follow the road round to the left. At the end of the road you will reach a 'T' junction with the village main street. Turn right and take the right hand turn into the car park, just before the old railway bridge.</p>
<p>TO LOCATION</p>	<p>FROM INGLETON VILLAGE CAR PARK: Turn right out of the car park, after the railway bridge branch off to the left and turn left again at the 'T' junction. Keep following the road past the Waterfalls car park and under the viaduct. As the road levels out at the top of the hill branch off to the right, just after the 'end of goods vehicle restriction' signs. Keep following this road until you reach St. Oswald's Parish Church and the Marton Arms pub. Take the first right on the bend after the church onto 'Thornton Lane.' We will park in a lay-by on the right hand side of the road after approximately 1 mile.</p>
