3	To understand how to balance and make the most of colour in your photographs

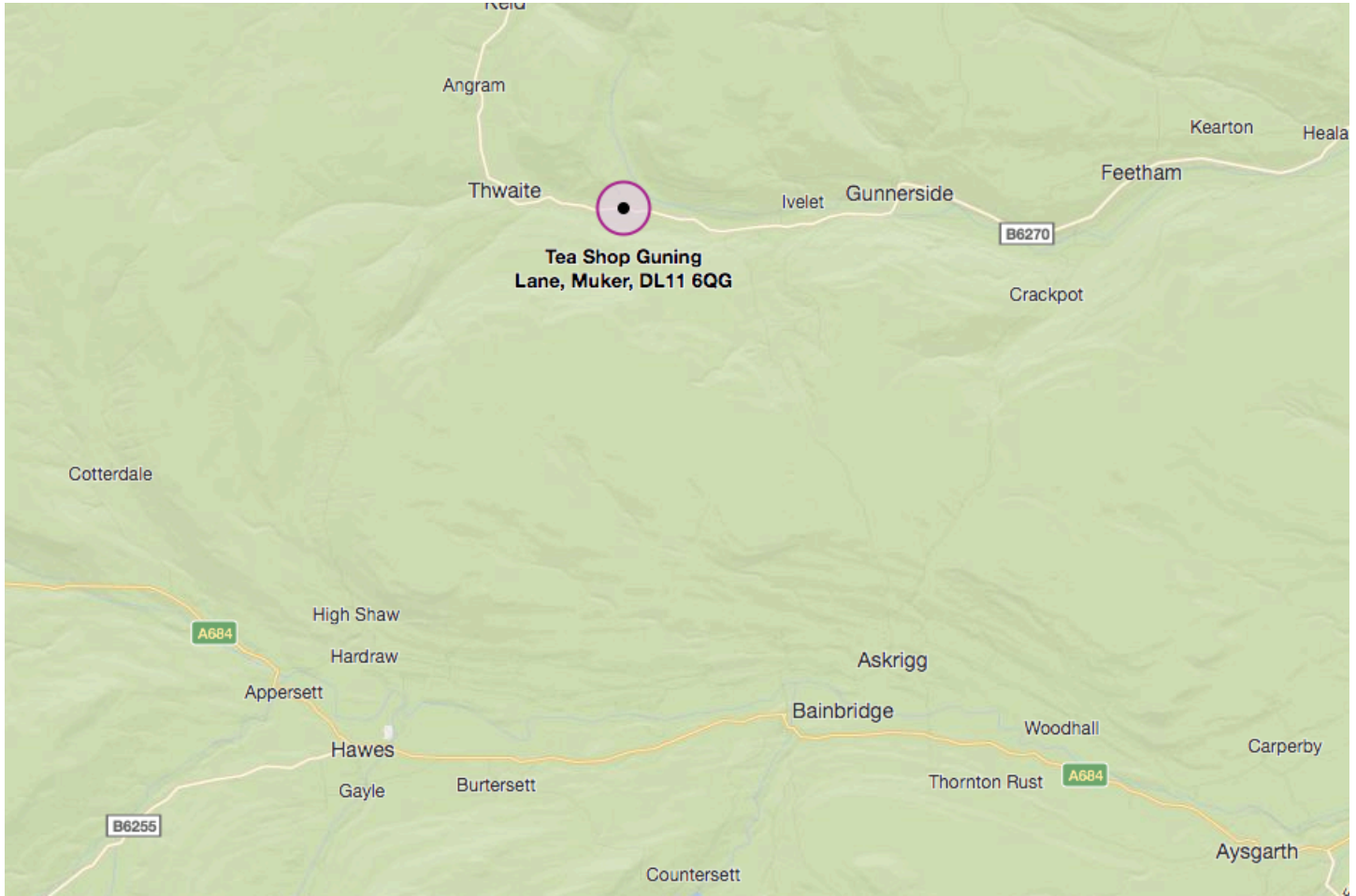
## WHAT TO BRING

LENSES	STANDARD 18-55mm LENS OR FULL FRAME EQUIVALENT AND A FAST LENS WITH A WIDEST APERTURE OF F3.5 OR WIDER
FILTERS	NOT REQUIRED
REMOTE	NOT REQUIRED
FOOT WARE	WALKING BOOTS/STURDY SHOES/TRAIL SHOES
CLOTHING	SUITABLE FOR THE CONDITIONS ON THE DAY
OTHER ESSENTIALS	INSECT REPELLANT

## LOCATION DIRECTIONS

<b>TO MEETING POINT</b>	<p><b>FROM RICHMOND:</b> Take the A6106 towards Leyburn. When the road forks, turn right, following signs to Reeth and Kirkby Stephen on the B6270. Follow this road through Swaledale to Muker Village. The car park is on the left, just before the bridge. The free on street parking is on the other side of the village adjacent to the stream.</p> <p><b>FROM HAWES:</b> Take Burnt Acres Road from the centre of Hawes, signposted Muker. At the top of the hill turn left at the 'T' Junction and then your next right, signposted Simonstone and Muker. Continue on this road over the Buttertubs Pass. On reaching the 'T' Junction at the other side of the pass turn right. On entering Muker Village there is free parking available on the right hand side of the road. The village car park is on the other side of the village on the right, just after the bridge.</p>
