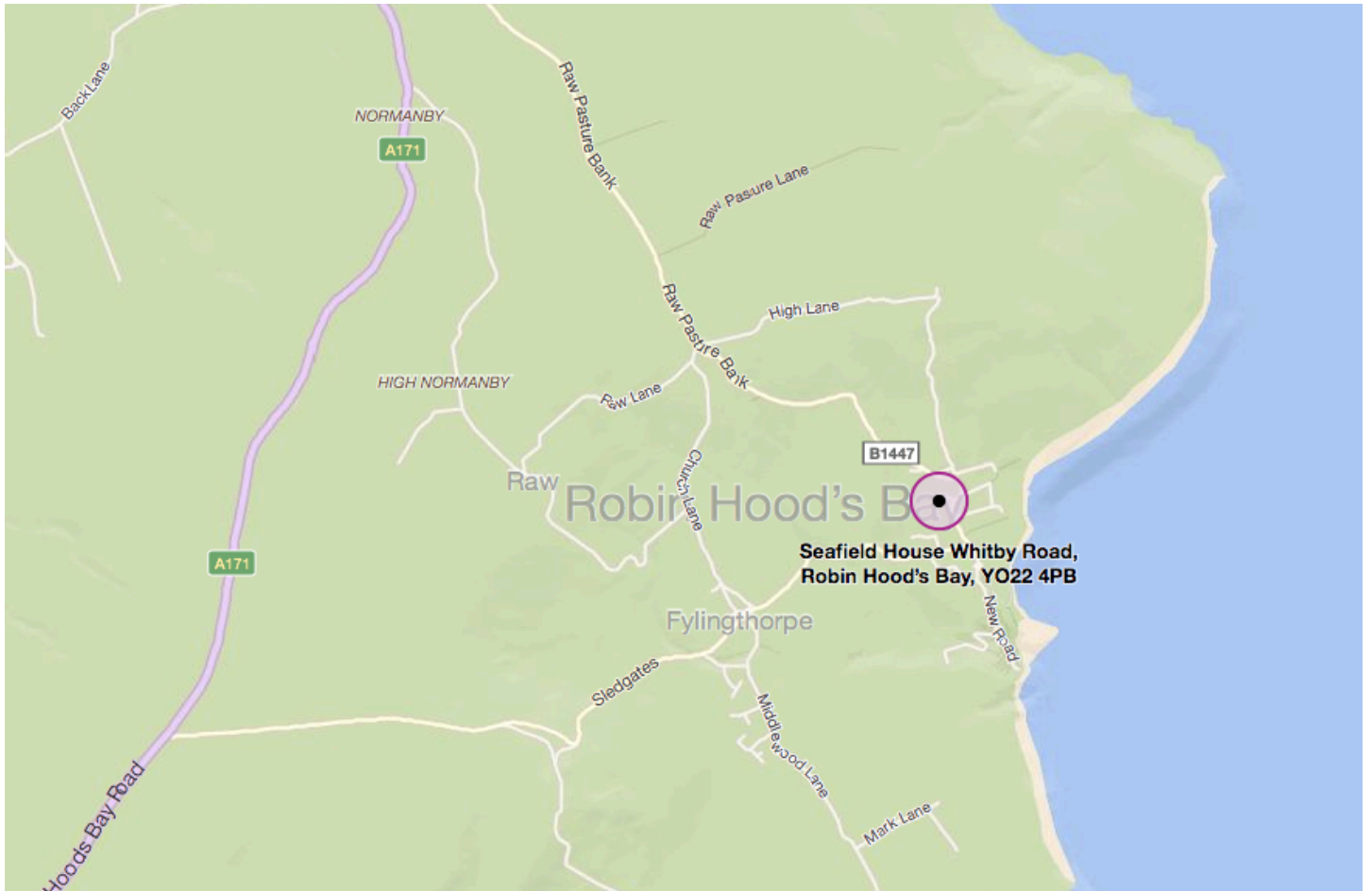
1	To understand how to take photographs underwater

## LOCATION DIRECTIONS

<p><b>TO MEETING POINT</b></p>	<p><b>FROM WHITBY:</b> Take the A171 out of Whitby following signs to Scarborough. On reaching the village of Hawsker, turn left onto the B1447, following signs to Robin Hood's Bay. At the bottom of the hill heading into the village turn right onto Station road. The entrance to the car park is on the right.</p> <p><b>FROM SCARBOROUGH:</b> Take the A171 out of Scarborough following signs to Whitby. After passing Fylingdales keep a look out for signs to Robin Hood's Bay and Fridaythorpe. Turn right off the A171 towards Robin Hood's Bay and Fridaythorpe, following the road down the steep hill. After passing through Fridaythorpe village the road twists and bends towards Robin Hood's Bay. Look out for a small turning on the right signposted 'Station Worksops' and Village Hall. Take this turning on the left, the car park is at the top of the hill.</p>
